Ice Maker Outlet Boxes- How to Use

- 1. Remove the faceplate from the icemaker box and insert the mounting brackets in the slots on the side of the box. Snap them into a depth that will place the front of the box slightly recessed from the finished wall surface when mounted on the studs.
- 2. Decide on how you are going to mount the box in your wall. (You may need to provide some wood to provide a firm installation.)
- 3. Mount the box on the by nailing or screwing through the existing holes in the brackets into the studding.
- 4. Plumb the water supply to the valve. Using copper solder 1/2" copper directly to the inside of the valve shank. Using CPVC or polybutylene use an adapter to 1/2" Male Iron Pipe thread.
- 5. After the line has been tested and the wall has been finished, snap the faceplate onto the box connect 1/4" OD to the water outlet on the valve.
